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The water level in Mopti has increased another 40 cm last week (27 – 3 September), reaching a level (536 cm) being higher than most years since 1994, although still 100 cm lower than on 3 September in 2018 and in 2016

(when the floods were very high). Hence OPIDIN predicts for 2019 a maximal flood level being about as high as in 2012-2015, but not as high as in 2016 and 2018.

The total rainfall in the Upper Basin until 3 September, calculated for the last 3 months, is close to the long-term average, which is another indication that the flood will be not extremely high.
