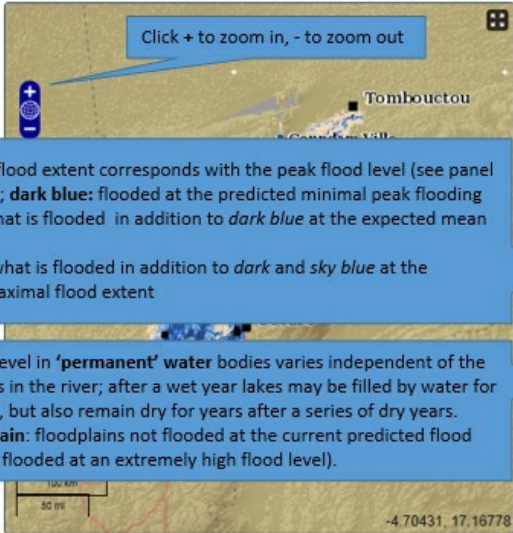


Click **print map** to get a print or pdf-file

Click + to zoom in, - to zoom out

Click here to remove **town and villages** from the map; click again to get this information back; the same applies for commune, cercle, etc. Smaller villages are only visible after zooming in.

The shown flood extent corresponds with the peak flood level (see panel on the left); **dark blue**: flooded at the predicted minimal peak flooding; **sky blue**: what is flooded in addition to *dark blue* at the expected mean flooding; **light blue**: what is flooded in addition to *dark* and *sky blue* at the expected maximal flood extent

The water level in '**permanent**' water bodies varies independent of the water levels in the river; after a wet year lakes may be filled by water for some years, but also remain dry for years after a series of dry years. **Dry floodplain**: floodplains not flooded at the current predicted flood extent (but flooded at an extremely high flood level).

The mouse cursor gives the longitude and latitude (decimal degrees).
